

## Delivery Options

### Option One: Through the corporate LMS or Intranet

QAI elearning courses can be delivered to organizations irrespective of whether they have their own LMS or not.

- **Organizations having an LMS:** The LMS available in an organization can be either SCORM compatible or non- SCORM compatible.
- **SCORM compliant LMS:** In case an organization has a SCORM compatible LMS, QAI Global Institute will help in plugging the course in the corporate LMS. All QAI elearning courses are designed in a way that they can be plugged in with all SCORM compatible LMS easily with little tweaking.
- **Non-SCORM LMS:** In case an organization has an LMS that is not SCORM compatible, QAI Global Institute will provide non-SCORM compatible courses. For such courses, there will not be any provision of tracking the progress of users as can be done through the LMS. However, in such a case the progress trackers built in the courses will work.
- **Organizations without an LMS:** QAI Global Institute can assist an organization which does not have its own LMS and is not keen on acquiring an LMS. QAI Global Institute can deliver courses in a form that can be run on the corporate Intranet.

### Option Two: Through the QAI Global Institute LMS

In case an organization does not want to run QAI elearning courses from its own LMS or Intranet, it can access them through the QAI Global Institute LMS hosted on the Internet. The QAI Global Institute LMS has features such as discussion board and chat, tracking and reporting, and performance and competency management.

Note: QAI Global Institute will provide answers to all technical queries regarding the QAI eLearning courses. This does not include installation and hosting support and troubleshooting in the organization's server environment (organization's LMS or Intranet). ### Option Three: Blended Learning Programs

The QAI eLearning courses can be plugged into an organization's instructor led program. Skill building trainings or knowledge-building introductory-level programs can be used with the instructor led trainings to make them more complete. This makes these trainings easy to track, thereby increasing the uniformity and effectiveness of the programs.
